## TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Private Candidates are charged an admin fee to cover their registration with Cambridge International.
- School Candidates requiring a separate venue due to special access arrangements and/or invigilator and/or reader and/or scribe will incur an additional cost, charged per paper.
- If specialist access arrangements are requested for which Cambridge International approval is required, this is by arrangement only and is dependent on our capacity. Please contact us directly by the stipulated deadline. Additional invigilation and arrangement costs may be incurred for our Candidates (refer to clause 26). The schools are not able to accommodate specialist access arrangements for Private Candidates, apart from extra-time.
- Charged per practical, per subject.
- Sciences include separately billable subjects, papers and practicals relating to the following:
  - Physical Sciences [IGCSE]
  - Chemistry [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
  - Physics [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
  - Biology [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
For the avoidance of any doubt, the Science Levy is charged separately for:
  - 1x Sciences Levy for Physical Science and/or Chemistry and
  - 1x Sciences Levy for Physical Science and/or Physics, and
  - 1x Sciences Levy for Biology
- Charged per candidate, per subject.
- The 'late payment fee' at 10% of outstanding exam invoice is charged to candidates that have not paid in full by the school's published payment deadline. Note that any payment made on the candidates account will be allocated to the oldest debt first. This deadline is set to ensure the school has sufficient time to process its examinations administration timeously. Thereafter, if Candidates do not pay by the deadline stipulated on the invoice they will be withdrawn and re-entered as late entries. The schools manage thousands of entries and requires sufficient time to administer, process and submit exam entries timeously in line with Cambridge International deadlines, and to avoid portal congestion, errors and missed deadlines.
- After the final entry closing date, we will charge late entry fees for any new entries you make, as well as for any entry amendments or syllabus changes. Entries or changes received after the published deadlines can cause disruption to carefully scheduled processes and cause significant additional work. Late entry fees are therefore applied to recover the costs of additional processing requirements, and to encourage the submission of entries by the published closing dates. Late entry fees will be charged in addition to the normal syllabus fee. Cambridge International may be unable to accept entry changes in the very late entries period if these are received too close to the exam.
- Courier costs relating to the sending/return of art is included in the practical fee however the fee is based on items being returned by courier and on work being a maximum size of A2. There may be an additional postage charge if the maximum size and/or weight is exceeded.
- Fees relating to re-moderation of school's coursework will be charged and split between the entire cohort requesting the re-moderation for IGCSE or AS/A Level respectively.
- A quote relating to your child/ren's estimated Cambridge International examination fees will be sent at the beginning of the school year

- for payment, for Candidates. Please note that this is only an estimate and may not be the final examination costs due to various changes that may occur during the academic year, e.g. subject changes. It is encouraged that this quote is paid as early as possible to avoid financial pressure prior to the final submission date to Cambridge International.
- An invoice for entry will be emailed to you for careful checking. Please notify us via email of necessary amendments immediately on receipt of the invoice. We cannot be held responsible for entry errors that should have been identified by you. Errors requiring amendment which are identified after the schools final entries date will incur the late penalty fee so please inform us before that date.
- All quotes given will be subject to fluctuations in the foreign exchange rate. Due to the nature of the Pound:Rand exchange rate, an adjustment may be required during the year, in which case an extra invoice may be sent to candidates.
- Date for full payment of the examination fees into the schools' bank account (same as school fees) will fall due and payable on the invoice date.
- Examination fees to be paid into the same bank account of the school/campus that the candidate attends, using the same reference assigned for school fees i.e. 'Student Name & Surname'.
- Private Candidates are to pay their examination fees into the bank account of the campus at which they will be writing. Please use your 'Student Name & Surname' as the reference.
- Examination fees to be paid in advance of the schools' submission of entries to Cambridge International.
- In the event that full examination fees are not paid in time to the schools based on the late entry payment deadline, the prospective candidate will not be registered for their relevant examination entries.
- Where prospective candidates have outstanding fees on their school account, any monies paid towards examination fees will be utilised against outstanding school fees first.
- We only refund all fees paid if you let us know about the withdrawal of a candidate before 20 February (for the June 2024 series), 15 August (for first-time entries for the November 2024 series) and 19 September (for retake entries for the November 2024 series). Candidates failing to let us know of a withdrawal on/before these deadlines will not receive a full refund of exam fees paid, except in exceptional circumstances (i.e. for medical reasons, following bereavement, or other exceptional circumstances). Withdrawals made on medical grounds must be supported by a medical certificate or, in the case of a bereavement, a letter on centre-headed paper. We only issue refunds after the end of the examination series.
- Examination fees for internal candidates and private candidates are valid between January 2024 to December 2024.
- Please refer to the Cambridge International subject offerings list for the subjects that are offered, per level, as exam opportunities. Subjects for which private candidates can be accommodated is dependant on the specific campus and its available capacity.
- Examinations requiring computer devices, not limited to Computer Science and/or ICT, require the student to have access to their own device to be able to prepare and practice for the specific examination as well as complete the examination.
- If a candidate makes use of a reader, scribe or similar, it is the candidate's responsibility to source it themselves. The school is not responsible to provide such services. This also applies to software used for access arrangements. Such costs are for the candidate's expense.
- Private Candidates will not be able to enrol for any subjects that have coursework components, e.g. Art & Design and Drama.
